- 3. All purchases shall be subject to audit and inspection by the other political subdivisions and Rockland County non profit agencies for which the purchase was made.
- 4. No officer, board or agency of a county, town, village, or school district shall make any purchase through the County when bids have been received for such purchase by such officer, board or agency, unless such purchase may be made upon the same terms, conditions and specifications at a lower price through the County.
- 5. SPECIFICATIONS

1. SCOPE

- 1.1. Provide labor equipment and material to rebuild, upgrade or furnish and deliver new sewage grinder units for the Rockland County Sewer District #1 (RCSD #1) as per the specifications. Units are Muffin Monster Sewage Grinders manufactured by JWC Environmental/Disposable Waste Systems. Work will be on an as needed basis.
- 1.2. The County of Rockland shall determine to refurbish the specified units on an as needed basis or replace specific units on an as needed basis.

2. SITE VISIT

2.1. All bidders are encouraged to visit the site. Bidder will be responsible to deliver item specified whether or not he/she visits the site. Contact Gene Yetter on (845) 365-6667 to arrange a site visit.

3. REQUIREMENTS – SECTION A – UPGRADE

- 3.1. GENERAL REQUIREMENT
 - 3.1.1. It is the intent of RCSD#1 that when an existing JWC Muffin Monster 30002 Series grinder is sent to be refurbished, the contractor shall upgrade each unit to the WIPE READY DESIGN 30005 SERIES GRINDERS as specified. Upgraded grinders shall be able to capture and shred wipes. Each upgraded unit shall have a new nameplate and new part number denoting the WIPE READY DESIGN.
 - 3.1.2. Unit pricing shall be provided per upgrade and include all labor, equipment, and material to complete the upgrade. Unit pricing shall include FOB Destination, Orangeburg, NY 10962.

3.2. EQUIPMENT DESCRIPTION

- 3.2.1. <u>Type</u>: Two-shaft design with two parallel shafts alternately stacked with intermeshing cutters and spacers positioned on the shaft to form a helical pattern. The two shafts shall counter-rotate with the driven shaft operating at approximately (2/3) the speed of the drive shaft.
- 3.2.2. Required Torque per Horsepower.
 - 3.2.2.1. Continuously: 1000 in-lbs. minimum.
 - 3.2.2.2. At Momentary Load Peaks: 3200 in-lbs.
- 3.2.3. Side Rails: the inside profile of the side rail shall be concave so as to closely follow the radial arc of the cutters. The side rails shall be affixed to the grinder so as to maintain a clearance not to exceed 5/16 inch between the major diameter of the cutter and the concave arc of the side rail thus assuring that particles larger than that clearance are directed toward the cutters to assure fineness of grind.
- 3.2.4. Bearings and Seals: The radial and axial loads of the shafts shall be borne by four sealed oversize Conrad-type ball bearings, which shall be rated by the bearing manufacturer with a minimum basic

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dynamic load rating of 7,050 lbs. The bearings shall be protected by a combination of a tortuous path device and end face-mechanical seals. Face materials must be a minimum of tungsten carbide to tungsten carbide, not requiring an external flush. The mechanical seal shall be rated at 60 PSI continuous duty by the seal manufacturer. The bearings and seals shall be housed in replaceable wear sleeves that support and align the bearings and seals.

3.3. MATERIALS

- 3.3.1. All grinder parts shall be manufactured by JWC Environmental or approved equal.
 - 3.3.1.1. <u>Grinder</u>: Corrosion resistant materials compatible so as to resist pitting due to cavitation or corrosion due to galvanic action.
 - 3.3.1.2. Shafts of the cutting cartridge: 4140 Heat Treated Hexagon Steel with a tensile strength rating of not less than 183,000 PSI.
 - 3.3.1.3. End Housing, Transition flanges, and Covers: Cast of Class 30 Grey Iron.
 - 3.3.1.4. Side Rails: Cast of ASTM A536-77 Ductile Iron.
 - 3.3.1.5. <u>Cutters and Spacers</u>: 4130 Heat Treated Alloy Steel, surface ground for uniformity and through-hardened a minimum 43-48 Rockwell "C." Cutters will have a minimum of 17 teeth and spacers shall be knurled.

3.4. WORK COVERED

- 3.4.1. Bidder shall list all work covered by his bid. This shall include, but is not limited to the following:
- 3.4.2. Unit Evaluation.
- 3.4.3. Housing Refurbishment.
- 3.4.4. Replacement with new interior parts to meet the Wipe Ready requirements.
- 3.4.5. Unit Measurement.
- 3.4.6. Shaft Replacement.
- 3.5. Interior working components shall include, but is not limited to, the following:
 - 3.5.1. Cutters Wipe Ready Grinders.
 - 3.5.2. Hex Shafts.
 - 3.5.3. All bearing/seal cartridges.
 - 3.5.4. Gears.
 - 3.5.5. Coupling.
 - 3.5.6. Gaskets, lubrication, etc.
- 3.6. Work shall not include motor, Gear reducer, reducer coupling, control, drive, extensions, hydraulics, and screens.

4. REQUIREMENTS – SECTION B – REFURBISH GRINDER UNITS

- 4.1. Provide pricing to furnish and deliver refurbished grinder units on an as needed basis. Upgraded Muffin Monster Model 30005 Wipe Ready Upgrade grinders that fail after the warranty period may be sent out to JWC repair shop to be refurbished. Refurbished grinders shall meet or exceed the requirements for Upgraded grinders as specified in section A.
- 4.2. Unit pricing shall include all labor, equipment and material to refurbish units as specified. Pricing offered shall include FOB Destination Orangeburg, NY 10962.

5. REQUIREMENTS - SECTION C - FURNISH AND DELIVER NEW GRINDER UNITS

- 5.1. Provide pricing to furnish and deliver new grinder units capable of shredding wipes on an as needed basis. Units offered shall be MFG. JWC Environmental, models referenced above, or approved equal.
- 5.2. Pricing offered shall include FOB Destination Orangeburg, NY 10962.

6. EQUIVALENT OR APPROVED EQUAL MATERIAL

- 6.1. Bidder must submit with their proposal, all specifications, testing data, etc. that demonstrate the substitute products meet all requirements.
- 6.2. Bidder must guarantee products are inter-connectable with existing equipment. Any required adaptations and/or adjustments required must be listed with the bid and must be approved by the authorized County of Rockland representative.

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6.3. Bidder must submit with bid 5 (five) locations where he has done this work on Muffin Monster Equipment. Include Model number, location, contact, telephone number, equipment and work completed.

7. EXPERIENCE

7.1. Bidder must have been doing this type of work for a period of 3 (three) years or more. Bidder shall complete the Certification of Experience.

8. GUARANTEES

8.1. Bidder must submit all guarantees, warrantees, etc. with bid.

9. AWARD

9.1. SECTIONS A AND B – UPGRADE AND REFURBISH UNITS

- 9.1.1. Sections A and B shall be awarded as a group to the lowest responsible responsive bidder. Quantities on the proposal pages are estimates. The amount of grinders that may be refurbished during the term of this bid will be based on the requirements of the Sewer District # 1.
- 9.1.2. To be considered for award of this section, bidder must submit pricing on ALL line items within Sections A & B.

9.2. SECTION C – FURNISH AND DELIVER NEW UNITS

9.2.1. Section C shall be awarded to the lowest responsible responsive bidder. The quantities on the proposal pages are estimates. Units may be purchased on an as needed basis.

10. PRICE ADJUSTMENT

- 10.1 The County recognizes this product or service has a price component that may have a commodity with changing costs. The Contractor/Supplier may request a Price Adjustment no more frequently than once Six months (6 -month period).
- 10.2 A Price Adjustment request must be made in writing and include the reason for the request, documentation supporting the request (i.e., commodity increases), the current pricing, and the requested revised pricing
- 10.3 The County will review the Price Adjustment request. If the Price Adjustment is deemed reasonable the Price Adjustment request will be accepted by written acknowledgement. If the request is not accepted the County may entirely reject the request or may counter with revised pricing. In either case the County will provide a written explanation in support of the decision.
- 10.4 The Director of Purchasing may use available indexes (e.g., CPI or PPI) to determine if the requested Price Adjustment is reasonable. Typically, a Price Adjustment that exceeds 5% will not be approved unless very unusual and significant changes have occurred in the industry.
- 10.5 In the event industry costs decline, the County shall have the right to receive, from the Contractor, a reasonable reduction in prices/pricing that reflect such cost changes in the industry. The County will make a written request to the Contractor for a Price Adjustment in writing with supporting documentation.
