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## **INTRODUCING THE**

### **EMPIRE STATE COOPERATIVE PROCUREMENT ALLIANCE**

The Counties of Chemung, Orange, Rockland, and Ulster (“Organizing Local Governments”), all being municipal corporations in the State of New York, have organized the Empire State Cooperative Procurement Alliance (“Alliance”) to serve all Public Participating Entities (as defined below) through the creation of a procurement cooperative to issue cooperative bids, operate and maintain an eSourcing, Contract Management and Marketplace E-Procurement System (“Solution”), and enable Alliance members to be in compliance with New York State bidding requirements, in identifying suppliers of commodities, good and services, and to realize the potential economies, including administrative cost savings.

The Organizing Local Governments of the Alliance have acted in accordance with section 119-o of the New York State General Municipal Law to cooperatively create the Alliance to fulfill their respective public and governmental purposes, needs, objectives and programs, and have additionally determined that Eligible Entities qualified shall be permitted to join the Alliance.

The Alliance entered into a multi-year agreement with mdf commerce (doing business as Periscope), whereby Periscope will provide electronic marketplace hosting and management services to enable eligible Public Participating Entities to access a central online website to view and/or shop the goods and services available from existing Alliance’s Cooperative Contracts. The central online website is referred to as “Empire Procure Connect.”

The County of Rockland officially distributes bidding documents through the Alliance’s Regional Bid Notification System via the BidNet Direct Portal. Suppliers may search for solicitation opportunities by logging into or registering with BidNet Direct using the following link:

When logged into BidNet Direct, search and locate the solicitation you are interested in, once selected the system will automatically transfer to the Empire Procure Connect’s portal where you can download the solicitation specifications and bid forms. 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**PURCHASES BY UNITED STATES AGENCIES, OTHER STATES AND POLITICAL  
 SUBDIVISIONS THEREIN, LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, SCHOOL DISTRICTS,  
 AND NON-PROFIT AGENCIES**

As per the New York State General Municipal Law, § 103(3) all political subdivisions of New York State are allowed to make purchases through the resulting contract(s). As per Rockland County Procurement Policy § 140-13, the United States of America or any agency thereof, any state, or any other political subdivision or district therein and certain Non-Profit Agencies approved to participate in New York State's Contract Extension Program are authorized to make purchases through the resulting contract(s).

1. The County of Rockland shall make all contract award information available to other political subdivisions and non-profit agencies through the **Empire Procure Connect Marketplace**.
2. Any other political subdivision or Rockland County non-profit agency will issue purchase orders directly to vendors within the specified contract period referencing the County's contract and shall be liable for any payments due on such purchase orders; and shall accept sole responsibility for any payment due.
3. All purchases shall be subject to audit and inspection by the other political subdivisions and Rockland County non-profit agencies for which the purchase was made.
4. No officer, board or agency of a county, town, village, or school district shall make any purchase through the County when bids have been received for such purchase by such officer, board or agency, unless such purchase may be made upon the same terms, conditions and specifications at a lower price through the County.
5. All Bidders shall be on notice that as a condition of the award of a County contract, the successful bidder shall accept the award of a similar contract with any other political subdivision in New York State and Rockland County non-profit agencies authorized to use New York State's contracts, if called upon to do so. A listing of approved Rockland County non-profit agencies is available on the Purchasing Division's website at [www.rcpurchasing.com](http://www.rcpurchasing.com). The County, however, will not be responsible for any debts incurred by the participants pursuant to this or any other agreement.
6. Necessary deviations from the County's specifications in the award of a participant contract, whether such deviations relate to quantities, or delivery points shall be resolved between the successful bidder and the other political subdivisions and Rockland County non-profit agencies.

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## **SPECIFICATIONS**

### **1. SCOPE**

- 1.1. Furnish pricing for specified gear reducers for the Rockland County Sewer District # 1 and the County of Rockland. This pricing must remain in effect for 3-year pricing structure as proposed in Proposal pages. Items will be purchased on an as needed basis. Reducers are to be Falk 1425WBW2A units as specified or approved equal.

### **2. PRICING STRUCTURE**

- 2.1. County of Rockland is looking to have firm pricing structure based on Year one, Year 2 and Year 3.
- 2.2. Year 2 and 3 pricing can not be higher more than a 5% increase than previous year pricing.
- 2.3. County of Rockland has the right to issue a new bid if pricing index shows a decrease in pricing for past 12 months change in pricing.
- 2.4. Vendor must submit pricing for all 3 years to be considered for an award.

- 5.2.1. Equipment shall be warranted against all defect in material and workmanship as specified by the manufacturer. All warranties from the manufacturer shall apply. Bidder shall, as part of its bid furnish its warranty/guarantee for all goods/services to be furnished hereunder. As a minimum, Bidder shall warrant all goods for a period of one year from date of acceptance. Bidder shall be obligated to repair or replace all defects in material or workmanship which are discovered or exist during said period.

**5.3. Approved Equal or Equivalent Products**

- 5.3.1. Bidders shall submit Manufacturer's product description and specifications.
- 5.3.2. Bidders shall list five entities currently using the product with like equipment (see certificate of Experience page in the bid package).
- 5.3.3. Bidder must guarantee in writing and submit with their bid the interconnectibility of item bid with existing equipment in the Rockland County Sewer District #1.
