- 2. Any other political subdivision or Rockland County non profit agency will issue purchase orders directly to vendors within the specified contract period referencing the County's contract and shall be liable for any payments due on such purchase orders; and shall accept sole responsibility for any payment due.
- 3. All purchases shall be subject to audit and inspection by the other political subdivisions and Rockland County non profit agencies for which the purchase was made.
- 4. No officer, board or agency of a county, town, village, or school district shall make any purchase through the County when bids have been received for such purchase by such officer, board or agency, unless such purchase may be made upon the same terms, conditions and specifications at a lower price through the County.
- 5. All Bidders shall be on notice that as a condition of the award of a County contract, the successful bidder shall accept the award of a similar contract with any other political subdivision in New York State and Rockland County non profit agencies authorized to use New York State's contracts, if called upon to do so. A listing of approved Rockland County non profit agencies is available on the Purchasing Division's website at www.rcpurchasing.com. The County, however, will not be responsible for any debts incurred by the participants pursuant to this or any other agreement.

SPECIFICATIONS

1. SCOPE

1.1. Pricing to furnish and deliver new Limitorque Actuators as specified or approved equal. All quantities are estimated, and orders will be placed on an as needed basis.

2. EQUIPMENT

- 2.1 Limitorque Model MXA-05/WG2B-OA electronic explosion proof electric valve actuator with 460 volt 3-ph motor with PTA full compliant AWWA gear and painted steel linkage to fit Pratt 6" ball valve. Actuator to be complete with local controls, manual override, 4 spare dry contacts, over torque switches and digital display.
- 2.2. Rockland County Sewer District has no immediate need Limitorque Model MXA-05/WG2B-OA actuator. The quantities listed are estimates and orders will be placed on an as needed basis.
- 2.3. Limitorque Model MXA -05/WG2B or approved equal, 460 Vac on/off actuators with linkage to fit 6" Pratt plug valve.

3. PRICING TERM

- 3.1. County of Rockland is looking to have firm pricing for one year with 2 additional options to extend.
- Pricing shall also be submitted for LOT Start UP Services / Wiring Termination Location Assistance Actual install / wiring to be done by Rockland County Sewer District #1.
- 3.6 Pricing shall be submitted for one (1) Man per four (4) hour day and eight (8) hour day
- 3.7 See Price adjustment Clause and Terrif Clause if market fluctuation is present.

4. GENERAL

- 4.1. The actuators that are being requested are replacements for existing units that are part of an engineered system. The replacement units must have the same physical, hydraulic, and material composition to be compatible with the existing system. Bidders are encouraged to visit the site. - 4.2. Vendors must perform as specified whether or not they visit the site.

5. BRAND NAME

5.1. The use of a brand name is for the purpose of describing a standard of quality, performance and characteristics desired and is not intended to limit or restrict competition.

6. APPROVED EQUAL OR EQUIVALENT PRODUCTS

6.1. Bidders shall submit an item listing and explanation of any differences between their products specifications and performance and the listed bid specifications. Product and service warranties must be included with bid.

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6.2. If bidders submit or bid for equivalent or approved equal products, they must submit manufacturer's product description and specifications. These specifications must include <u>all</u> items listed in the bid specifications.

- 6.3. Bidders must list five entities currently using the product on the certification of experience page in the bid package.
- 6.4. Bidder must be able to demonstrate within one week after notice and guarantee in writing that the item bid is interconnectable with existing equipment without the use of adaptors.

7. DELIVERY

7.1. All deliveries shall be made to the Rockland County Sewer District # 1 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 2:30 PM, Monday through Friday excluding holidays.

8. AWARD

8.1. Bid shall be awarded to the lowest responsive responsible bidder as a whole meeting the specifications of the RFB. The quantities listed are estimates. The actual amounts ordered will depend on the requirements of the Rockland County Sewer District #1.

9. Fixed Pricing with Tariff Adjustment Clause

9.1. Pricing shall be firm for the initial contract term; however, should tariffs imposed by the U.S. government materially change, the awarded contractor may request a price adjustment. Such requests must include official documentation verifying the tariff change and will be subject to County approval."

10. PRICE ADJUSTMENT

10.1. The County recognizes this product, or service has a price component that may have a commodity with changing costs. The Contractor/Supplier may request a Price Adjustment upon each contract renewal request. A Price Adjustment request must be made in writing and include the reason for the request, documentation supporting the request (ie, commodity increases), the current pricing, and the requested revised pricing.

The County will review the Price Adjustment request. If the Price Adjustment is deemed reasonable the Price Adjustment request will be accepted by written acknowledgement. If the request is not accepted the County may entirely reject the request or may counter with revised pricing. In either case the County will provide a written explanation in support of the decision.

The Director of Purchasing may use available indexes (e.g. CPI or PPI) to determine if the requested Price Adjustment is reasonable. Typically, a Price Adjustment that exceeds 5% will not be approved unless very unusual and significant changes have occurred in the industry.

In the event industry costs decline, the County shall have the right to receive, from the Contractor, a reasonable reduction in prices/pricing that reflect such cost changes in the industry. The County will make a written request to the Contractor for a Price Adjustment in writing with supporting documentation.
