NOTICE – Pricing for this solicitation is to be entered electronically through the Bidnet Direct Portal. All pricing and documents are to be submitted by **3:00PM on December 30, 2025.**

TERM: One (1) year with two (2) six (6) month options to renew

DELIVERY: Various Rockland County Departments

Medical Surveillance Service

The contractor will provide Hepatitis A and/or B Surface antibody titer screening to all referred County employee's when employee's claim immunity to Hepatitis A and/or B, when required according to the job's essential functions.

The contractor will provide Hepatitis A and/or B immunizations if the referred employee does not claim immunity or the test comes back negative. The contractor will provide employees and the authorized department representative notification and appointment scheduling required for completion of the immunization series.

The contractor will ensure that all procedures are performed by or under the direct supervision of a licensed physician.

The contractor will provide post-exposure medical evaluation and follow up to referred conversion response to HAV and/or HBV.

The contractor will provide post-exposure medical evaluation and follow-up to referred employees according to CDC recommendations. The medical evaluations will consist of:

- Blood draws to determine HAV/ and HBV status
- Source client blood draws to determine HAV and HBV status.
- Result notification of source client's lab results to the employee.
- The contractor will provide exposed employee with counseling and medical evaluation for any resulting HAV and HBV related illness.

Contractor shall provide post-exposure prophylaxis when medically indicated. This will include employee consultation of any potential side effects or adverse reaction caused by prophylaxis treatment in accordance with OSHA and PESH Recommendations for Post exposure Prophylaxis.

Contractor shall follow CDC modified protocol for employees that continue to display no immunity to Hepatitis A and/or B and start another series of immunizations.

The contractor shall administer services on County of Rockland sites or at contractor facilities at the locations, dates and times mutually agreed unless otherwise agreed. Initial program services will be performed on County of Rockland sites but as employees require retesting and additional immunizations may be scheduled at contractors' facility.

Reporting

The contractor will maintain all employee immunization records and exposure reports as required and provide copies to the authorized county representative.

All procedures, reporting, record keeping and related communicable disease monitoring, prevention treatment and other occupational health monitoring activities shall be provided by the contractor in compliance with relevant City, State, and Federal Laws, rules and regulations, HIPAA, and such as those promulgated by OSHA and the Center for Disease

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Control. Such procedures, reports and records shall be released only to authorized persons as designated by the County in a format acceptable to the County.

Contractor shall be liable for any damages resulting from these services and/or reporting of inaccurate results for any reason.

Depending on the using department, employees identified in the exposure determination will be asked to sign a Hepatitis Immunization Liability Waiver Form. Contractor will prepare and issue a liability waiver to each employee receiving the vaccine and maintain the form. A copy of this form shall be provided to the authorizing departmental representative. This form will notify employees that, should they decline to accept the vaccine, yet experience continued occupational exposure, they can at any time ask for and receive the vaccine series without cost to themselves.

The contractor will maintain all medical records and manage reminder/recall systems for updating required immunizations and annual screenings to include but not limited to, written reminders of Hepatitis immunizations and vaccinations, and due dates.

Quality Control

The contractor response shall include Quality Control procedures as it would relate to the services identified in the specifications of this RFQ.

The contractor shall develop a quality assurance system encompassing record review and meetings with the authorized departmental representative. The location and scheduling of such meetings if needed, shall be determined by a county representative.

The contractor shall employ the service of an outside licensed physician, board-certified in occupational medicine, solely for the purpose of reviewing medical records as a means of providing quality assurance.

Documentation of the reviewing physicians' board certification shall be provided as part of the quality assurance system.

A quality assurance review shall be conducted biannually, with findings submitted to the authorized county representative in each contract term.

There are approximately eighty (80) Rockland County Sewer District #1 employees that will be covered under this service program. Other authorized County of Rockland agencies will also be able to take advantage of the awarded program and pricing on an as needed basis.

Please note that the number of employees included in this medical program or service varies with time and circumstances of employment and the numbers presented should not be construed as an absolute guarantee of the service requirement levels. Determination for employee inclusion or removal from this medical program is predicated upon job duties and exposure profile criteria and is decided by the authorized representative of the department.
