SCOPE

The County of Rockland seeks to award a contract for the testing of non-potable water samples from its Oil/Water Separator to satisfy the requirements of the Rockland County Fire Training Center's New York State Pollutant Elimination System (SPEDS) permit.

SAMPLE DESCRIPTIONS:

Currently SPEDS requires three (3) different types of analyses:

Total Suspended Solids (TSS) per EPA Method SM2540D

Oil & Grease per EPA Method 1664B

pH per EPA Method SM4500H B

SAMPLE PICKUP REQUIREMENTS:

Contractors shall be required to perform field sampling. Two samples are to be taken for analysis. Samples and Analysis shall be done quarterly in March, June, September, and December.

Sampling shall be grab type

The successful bidder will provide sample bottles at no additional cost.

REPORT

Report of analysis shall be sent to Mr. Christopher Kear, Rockland County Fire Training Center, 35 Fireman's Memorial Drive, Pomona, New York 10970.

Results must be made available within **ten (10) business days**, after pickup of samples by the contract Laboratory.

The final hard copy report containing the test results must be received by the Fire Training Center within **15 business days** after pickup.

QUALIFICATIONS

Laboratories (Laboratory) and any subcontract laboratories to be used for this work must have N.Y.S. certification for wastewater analyses from the N.Y.S. Dept. of Health Environmental Laboratory Approval Program (ELAP) or certified under the National Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Conference (NELAC) Program approved by any NELAC accredited state laboratory certification program.

Certifications shall be submitted with the bid proposal.

Test methods can be subcontracted out as long as the subcontractor follows the same criteria for testing and are certified by the ELAP program.

The costs of all QA/QC shall be borne by the Laboratory and included in the unit prices bid for the various parameters.

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The Laboratory must be staffed by technically competent persons. Resumes of key technical staff must be submitted with proposal.

All analytical results will be reported to three (3) significant figures or those figures defining the accuracy of the analytical results. Results reported as "less than" (<) should only be used when the result is less than the method detection limit (MDL). The units for reporting all parameters should be consistent for each report.

All analytical reports shall include:

A separate results report for each sample ID number

The date sample was analyzed and/or extracted.

The analysis method used for each parameter (EPA 200.7, OIA 1677, etc.)

Person/persons who analyzed and/or extracted the sample.

Method detection limit for the parameter.

Quality Assurance and quality control (QA/QC) record for phenols, oil and grease (polar and non- polar), and organics analyses using GC or GC/MS instrumentation. QA/QC record includes: method blank, standards calibration, recovery data summary and QA/QC conformance summary.

Any additional QA/QC records upon request by the County.

Bidder shall specifically identify any testing that will be subcontracted. Bidder shall submit, with their bid, a detailed listing of which test(s) will be subcontracted, disclose full name and address of the subcontractor and submit their certifications. Failure to properly identify subcontractors and provide subcontractor certification may deem your bid as non-responsive.

All analyses must be done by methods indicated, or an equivalent method that is listed in the ELAP test methods, and by methods prescribed in the Federal Register (FR) (40 CFR-Part 136 and subsequent FR directives).

EXPERIENCE

Bidder shall have a minimum three (3) years of experience providing laboratory analysis for the types of categories defined in these specifications.

Bidder shall provide, with their bid, references from at least three (3) firms or government agencies where laboratory analyses for these types of categories have been performed. Bidder may include the County of Rockland as a reference if the bidder is currently providing (or in the past has provided) services to the County. Bidder shall provide proof of the minimum experience requirements stated above. The Certificate of Experience form shall be completed and submitted with the bid in accordance with these specifications. Failure to submit this form may deem your bid non-responsive.

QUANTITIES

The quantities are estimated and reflect anticipated requirements for a twelve-month period.

The contract, however, shall be for the quantities actually ordered during the contract period.

PRICING

Bidders are required to submit unit pricing to provide all labor, equipment, material and report charges to perform laboratory analysis in accordance with the specifications and items listed on the proposal pages.

AWARD

This contract shall be awarded, to the lowest responsible responsive bidder meeting the stated requirements
