SPECIFICATIONS

1. SCOPE

- 1.1. The scope of this bid is to provide unit pricing to furnish and deliver replacement parts listed for various Flowsolve Worthington Pumps. These prices are to remain in effect for one year from date of award with the choice option to renew for one additional year. Items will be ordered on an as needed basis.
- 1.2. Bidder Must provide a % Discount off of Mfg. list price for any items needed that are not specifically listed on the proposal pages. Bidder to upload current Mfg. List Price with their bid submission.
 - 1.2.1. Bidder Must provide RCSD#1 with a quote for any parts under this line award. The quote Must contain a detailed description of the part(s) being requested, part #, and the current Mfg. List Price less the Discount and show the overall Net Price.
 - 1.2.2. All pricing provided Must include FOB Destination Prepaid and Allowed, Orangeburg, NY 10962.

2. GENERAL

- 2.1. The equipment that is being requested is a replacement for the existing equipment and must have the same physical, hydraulic and material composition to be compatible with the existing system. **No adapters are allowed.**
- 2.2. Bidders are encouraged to visit the site. Site visits can be arranged by calling Josue Thomas at (845) 365-6495. Vendor's equipment must perform as specified whether or they visit the site.

3. BRAND NAME

- 3.1. The use of a brand name is for the purpose of describing a standard of quality, performance and characteristics desired and is not intended to limit or restrict competition.

4. APPROVED EQUAL OR EQUIVALENT PRODUCTS

- 4.1. Bidders Must submit an item by item listing and comparison between their products specifications and performance and the specifications and performance of the listed bid specifications. Product and service warranties must be included with bid. Failure to comply with this requirement Must deem your bid as non-responsive.
- 4.2. If bidders submit or bid for equivalent or approved equal products, they must submit manufacturer's product description and specifications. These specifications must include all items listed in the bid specifications.
- 4.3. Bidders must list five entities currently using the product on the certification of experience page in the bid package.
- 4.4. Bidder Must be able to demonstrate within three days after notification and guarantee in writing the interconnectability of equivalent products with existing equipment.

6. QUANTITIES

6.1. Quantities are estimated. Parts will be ordered on an as needed basis.

7. PRICE ADJUSTMENT

7.1. The County recognizes this product or service has a price component that may have a commodity with changing costs. The Contractor/Supplier may request a Price Adjustment no more frequently than once each quarter (3-month period).

A Price Adjustment request must be made in writing and include the reason for the request, documentation supporting the request (ie, commodity increases), the current pricing, and the requested revised pricing.

The County will review the Price Adjustment request. If the Price Adjustment is deemed reasonable the Price Adjustment request will be accepted by written acknowledgement. If the request is not accepted the County may entirely reject the request or may counter with revised pricing. In either case the County will provide a written explanation in support of the decision.

The Director of Purchasing may use available indexes (e.g. CPI or PPI) to determine if the requested Price Adjustment is reasonable. Typically, a Price Adjustment that exceeds 5% will not be approved unless very unusual and significant changes have occurred in the industry.

In the event industry costs decline, the County shall have the right to receive, from the Contractor, a reasonable reduction in prices/pricing that reflect such cost changes in the industry. The County will make a written request to the Contractor for a Price Adjustment in writing with supporting documentation.

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8. DELIVERY

8.1. All deliveries Must be made to the Rockland County Sewer District # 1 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 2:30 PM, Monday – Friday, excluding holidays.

9. AWARD

9.1. Bid will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder that meets the stated requirements. The County reserves the right to award this contract on a line by line basis should it be deemed in the best interest of the County.
